How to Use This Checklist

Before the viewing: Check the car's MOT history at **motninja.co.uk** — look for patterns in advisories and failures. **At the viewing:** Work through each section systematically. Don't rush. **After inspection:** Any "Critical" flags = walk away or negotiate hard. Multiple "Important" flags = budget £1,000+ for repairs.

	Section 1: Before You Arrive (Digital Checks)
	1. Full MOT History Check CRITICAL Run VRM through motninja.co.uk. Look for: advisory patterns (same issue recurring), mileage progression (should increase consistently), test frequency (annual is normal, multiple tests in short periods = retest after failure).
	2. Finance Outstanding Check CRITICAL MOT Ninja Premium (£9.49) reveals if finance is still owed. NEVER buy a car with outstanding finance — the lender can legally repossess it.
	3. Write-Off Check CRITICAL Category S/N (structural/non-structural damage) cars are legal but worth 20-40% less. Category A/B cars should not be on the road at all.
	4. Stolen Vehicle Check CRITICAL MOT Ninja Premium checks Police National Database. If stolen, you lose both car AND money.
DATA INSIGHT FROM 62,898 MOT TESTS Cars with consistent advisory patterns (e.g., "corrosion near suspension" for 3+ years) fail MOT 40% more often	

than clean-history equivalents. This is your early warning system.

5. Panel Gaps & Alignment IMPORTANT Uneven gaps between bonnet/doors/boot = accident repair. Run finger along seams — should be smooth. Misaligned panels often hide structural damage. 6. Paint Condition IMPORTANT Look in daylight. Colour mismatch between panels = respray (why?). Orange-peel texture = cheap respray. Stone chips are normal; rust bubbles are not. 7. Tyre Tread & Wear Pattern CRITICAL Legal minimum: 1.6mm. Safe minimum: 3mm. Uneven wear (one side worn more) = suspension/alignment issues. Check all 4 tyres + spare. Budget £400+ for full set. 8. Glass & Windscreen IMPORTANT Chips bigger than £2 coin = MOT fail. Cracks in driver's vision = fail. Chips can spread — budget £50-£200 for repair/replacement. 9. Lights (All Functions) RECOMMENDED Test headlights (dipped & full beam), brake lights, indicators (all 4 corners), hazards, fog lights, reverse lights. One bulb = £5, full LED unit = £500+. 10. Underbody Rust Inspection CRITICAL Look underneath (use phone torch). Surface rust on exhaust/suspension = normal. Holes, flaking metal, or rust near sills/subframe = structural issue. Coastal cars rust faster.

II DATA INSIGHT FROM 62,898 MOT TESTS

Section 2: Exterior (Walk Around)

Suspension and exhaust corrosion cause 30% of all MOT failures. If you see rust, negotiate £800-£1,200 off asking price — that's the typical repair cost.

Test: windows (all 4), central locking, air con/heating, radio, wipers, horn, heated seats. Electric faults are expensive to

19. Damp/Water Damage IMPORTANT

20. Cold Start CRITICAL Insist on cold engine (not warmed up). Should start immediately. Blue smoke = burning oil (engine wear). White smoke (not steam) = coolant leak. Black smoke (diesel) = injector/turbo issue.
21. Steering Feel IMPORTANT Should be light, responsive, no pulling to one side. Heavy steering = power steering pump. Pulling = alignment or suspension. Vibration = wheel balance or suspension bushes.
22. Brake Performance CRITICAL Should stop smoothly, no pulling, no juddering. Grinding noise = pads worn to metal (£150-£300). Soft pedal = air in system or leak. Vibration at speed = warped discs.
23. Gear Changes (Manual/Auto) CRITICAL Manual: Should be smooth, no crunching, no jumping out of gear. Clutch should bite halfway up pedal. Auto: Should change smoothly, no jerking, no delay. Clutch/gearbox repair = £800-£2,000.
24. Unusual Noises IMPORTANT Knocking over bumps = suspension bushes (£300-£500). Whining at speed = wheel bearing (£150-£300/wheel). Rattling = exhaust heat shield or loose component.
25. Turbo Function (If Applicable) IMPORTANT Should accelerate smoothly with power. Whistling/whining = turbo wear. Lack of power = boost leak or turbo failure (£500-£1,500 to replace).

II DATA INSIGHT FROM 62,898 MOT TESTS

Section 5: Test Drive (Critical Assessment)

Cars that fail on **brakes or suspension** in one MOT fail again within 2 years in 65% of cases. If this car recently passed MOT with brake/suspension advisories, budget for imminent repairs.

Section 6: Paperwork (Final Verification)
26. Service History CRITICAL Full service history (FSH) = stamped book or digital records. Our data: FSH cars pass MOT 15-20% more often. Missing
services = walk away or negotiate £500-£1,000 off.
27. V5C Logbook & ID Verification CRITICAL
Seller's name must match V5C. Check VIN on V5C matches VIN on car (windscreen/door pillar). Colour/engine size should match. No V5C = potential stolen car or outstanding finance.
Your Notes & Red Flags



WALK AWAY IF:

- Any "Critical" flag fails
- Outstanding finance or stolen status
- Warning lights stay on (especially engine/DPF/airbag)
- Major structural rust or accident damage
- No service history + high mileage
- Seller won't allow proper inspection

▲ NEGOTIATE HARD IF:

- 3+ "Important" flags
- Recent MOT advisories on expensive items
- Tyres/brakes need replacing soon (deduct £400-£600)
- Service due or missed (deduct £200-£400)
- Minor cosmetic damage

SAFE TO PROCEED IF:

- All "Critical" checks pass
- · Clean MOT history with no recurring advisories
- Full service history
- Mileage matches model age and condition
- Test drive feels solid
